CWJC provides women a hand up not a hand out. We provide life skills/job skills classes for women who are ready to make a change in their life. We provide a mentor for every woman who enrolls in our program. Bible study is a major factor in everything that we do. Every woman is given the opportunity to accept Jesus as her Savior. Classes are held three days a week for fifteen weeks. There are two sessions a year. We provide all materials including a Bible to the participant free of charge. Our Kid's Corps program is designed to not only take care of preschool children while their mother is in class but to provide learning activities to better prepare them for school. 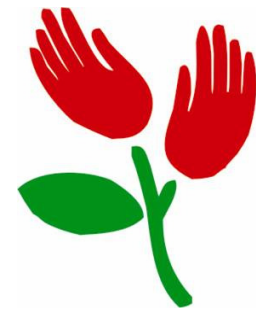
